TRAPEZE ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Unwrap the trapeze by removing all of the packing materials.

You will have the following parts: two side upright extensions with four attached arms and a top bar.

The Purrington trapeze is designed to be very flexible in placement. Where you place the trapeze is determined by the type of loom you have and also the layout of your studio. The placement of the trapeze is not precise and may need adjustments to clear obstructions on your loom. The trapeze can be used on the front or back of most looms.



The trapeze can be used with a table loom by clamping BOTH the trapeze and the loom to the table.

Using the provided clamps, attach the trapeze arms to secure points on your loom. You will make attachments at lower and upper points on each side of the loom. It is critical to ensure that the length of extension of the arms from the loom is the same distance on the left and right sides. To put it in other words, the uprights MUST be parallel

Finally, slide the top bar into the slot in the top of the side upright extensions and tighten the wing nuts.

You are now ready to begin warping utilizing your trapeze. Please see the Trapeze User Instructions.
